- Must be able to lead worship vocally and instrumentally, with guitar and/or piano keyboard
- At least one year removed from High School
- A background check will be conducted for this position
- Ability and willingness to:
  - practice servant leadership while working collaboratively within a team
  - support a friendly and inclusive environment for both campers and fellow staff
  - perform in potentially strenuous physical activities (hiking and lifting/moving gear)
  - give and receive constructive feedback
  - demonstrate innovative problem-solving in fast-paced environments
  - nurture spiritual growth by helping campers encounter God through His creation

**General and Specific Responsibilities:**

- Ensure high-quality camper supervision
- Coordinate morning and evening worship each week through songs, skits, and scripture

- Select appropriate worship songs and prepare visuals/printed lyrics for worship services
- Serve in all areas of camp ministry including recreation, food services, housekeeping, etc. in a busy Christian summer camp environment
- Keep living and common areas clean, organized, and well-maintained
- Participate in all staff clean up at the end of the summer
- Encourage a group culture that supports team-building and belonging for all campers

- Incorporate summer curriculum and theme through worship
- Emphasize intentionality in spiritual growth and development
- Create an environment that allows campers to discover and develop their God-given gifts, strengths, and leadership skills
